February

Soil test, liming based on soil results

March

18-0-9 w / .125% Dimension / 40% NS-54

Spring Pre-Emergent

- This application will prevent summer annual weeds such as crabgrass, goosegrass, and broadleaf weeds
 - Apply product at medium rate for 4.8 lbs product / 1,000 SF
 - 50 lbs treats 10,800 SF
 - Irrigate immediately after application @ 1/2"

May

15-0-15 / 50% Nutrisphere / 5% Fe

Early Summer Fertilization

- This application contains both readily and slowly available nitrogen for extended periods of growth. This product also contains 5% iron for turf color enhancement.
 - Apply at the medium rate (6.67 lbs / 1,000 SF)
 - 50 lbs feeds 7,400 SF (0.17 acre) with 1.00 lbs N/1,000 SF
 - Irrigate immediately after application @ 1/2"

June/July

Duocide insect treatment

- This treatment is a broad spectrum insecticide for both preventative and curative control of surface and subsurface feeding insects ("over & under"). This product contains bifenthrin and carbaryl for multimode insect control.
- Apply at medium rate for 4lbs product / 1,000 SF
- Irrigate immediately after application @ 1/2"

25-5-12 / 50% NS-54 / 2% Fe / micros

Mid Summer Fertilization

- This product contains polymer coated sulfur coated urea which helps reduce the risk of nitrogen burn, while slowly releasing the nitrogen.
- Apply at medium rate to apply 4.00 lbs N / 1,000 SF
- Irrigate immediately after application @ 1/2"

August

16-4-8 / 40% NS-54 / 2% Fe

Late Summer Fertilization

- This product contains proprietary NS-52 coated slow release nitrogen to provide uniform growth with extended nitrogen feeding.
 - Apply product at medium rate (6.25 lbs / 1,000 SF)
 - 50 lbs covers 8,000 SF (0.18 acre) with 1.00 lbs N / 1,000 SF
 - Irrigate immediately after application @ 1/2"

5-5-25 w/ 0.426% Barricade

Fall Pre Emergent / Potash Fertilization


- This product will prevent winter annual weeds such as "Poa Annua" annual bluegrass, Carolina geranium, and other broadleaf weeds.
- Apply product at medium rate to apply 5.4 lbs product / 1,000 SF
- 50 lbs treats 9,200 SF (0.21 acre) to apply 1.00 lbs of ai/A
- Irrigate immediately after application @ 1/2"
